At the same time, the institute keeps the students aware of the social values to build proper "belief system" in them.

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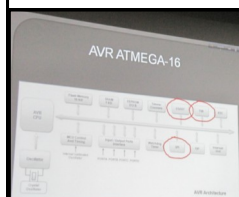
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ANURANAN PHASE II- OPEN SOURCE HARDWARE
